

## Foundation Announces 2nd Annual Golf Tournament – Friday, June 10, 2011

Foundation Development and Fundraising Vice President Melanie Kuykendall states, "Our 2nd Annual Golf Tournament has been formed to enable the Foundation to raise funds for general operating expenses and funding academic initiatives in the Quinlan school district. Since inception in 2006, the Foundation has awarded \$80,000 in teacher grants focusing on instructional enhancement and math/science initiatives. In addition, the Foundation awarded an additional \$5,000 in 2009 towards the District being able to start The Edge – Breaking Limitations after-school program. Further, the Foundation has approved awarding an additional \$20,000 in teacher grants for the 2010-2011 school year. The total amount of grant monies awarded to QISD by the Foundation will top \$105,000 this fall."

Kuykendall goes on to say, "Your participation and any donations to the Foundation will help our organization be a sustainable source of funds to the District for many years. The Foundation is a partner to Quinlan ISD and all proceeds benefit initiatives in the classroom that are not normally allowed in the District's annual school budget."

"Our schools and our children deserve every resource available. They deserve to have the same opportunities as property-wealth districts. The Foundation is one way to allow more enrichment and opportunities to the District," said Kuykendall.
